

PLEASE NOTE

Dogs: There is a one-time fee of € 6,00 for the ascent and descent.

Groups: Travel groups of 15 persons and more and school classes receive reduced fares

Disabled persons: With a degree of disability from 60 % or "G" we grant discounts on ascents and descents as well as round trips with the cable cars and the cogwheel train upon presentation of the disability card.

Discounts: Free ride for children under 6 when accompanied by a parent or adult guardian. Family tickets are valid for children from 6 to including 18 years accompanied by at least one parent.

No free transport of people with disabilities according to § 228 SGB IX (German Social Insurance Code vol. IX) on the cogwheel train between Grainau and Zugspitze and on the cable cars, chair lifts and drag lifts operated by Bayerische Zugspitzbahn Bergbahn AG. On purchase of a ticket, passengers are bound by the general conditions of carriage, which are publicly displayed at all stations. Tickets are non-transferable. ID required for reduced tariffs. HIKING AND CLIMBING PARADISE

AT THE FOOT OF THE ALPSPITZE

The Alpspitze, the jewel of the Werdenfelser Land, towers majestically above the Garmisch-Classic area. A sight that makes the hearts of all mountain lovers beat faster. In the wild and romantic alpine landscape between Alpspitze, Kreuzeck and Hausberg there are hiking trails in every level of difficulty. Short trippers, fit seniors and families will find many beautiful tours that leave enough time to rest and enjoy nature.

The starting points for small and large hikes can be reached easily with the Alpspitz- and Kreuzeckbahn cable cars. In addition, the complete spectrum of alpine climbing is possible in the grippy Wetterstein limestone of the Alpsitze area. From the mountain station of the Alpspitzbahn cable car climbers can reach an unbelievable variety of high alpine tours and via ferratas after only 15 minutes ascent.

GERMANY'S HIGHEST PEAK

ZUGSPITZE - TOP OF GERMANY

At 2,962 meters above sea level, the Zugspitze in southern Bavaria outdoes every other mountain in Germany. Thanks to convenient cable car and railway facilities you do not need to be a tenacious mountaineer to get to the summit. Visitors from all over the world love the mountain for its glacier, four-country panoramic views and summit restaurant.

The modern Cable car Zugspitze, the ageless cogwheel train and the Gletscherbahn cable car make the Zugspitze a highly accessible destination. On the very top, Germany's most beautiful roof terrace is a popular spot to enjoy the unique 360° panorama of 400 alpine peaks in Germany, Austria, Italy and Switzerland. The golden summit cross at eye level can be admired year-round. Looking out into the distance on a clear day – up to 250 kilometers – brings an unbelievable feeling of space and freedom.

ENDANGERED WORLDS

THE GLACIERS ON ZUGSPITZE

On Zugspitze you can find two of the last glaciers in Germany - the Nördliche Schneeferner and the Höllentalferner. Even in high summer you will feel the primal force of the elements and discover, how over millennia wind, snow, ice and sun have shaped the mountain landscape at 2,600 meters above sea level. But also the "eternal ice" on Zugspitze is actually threatened by global warming. Already in 2022, the Südliche Schneeferner at plateau Zugspitze has lost its status as a glacier. Now it is categorized as dead ice. The Nördliche Schneeferner will also be completely melted in

A circular trail on plateau Zugspitze gives interesting facts about the glacier and shows the changes that have taken place over the last few decades. Interested visitors can also take part in guided tours with the glacier guides to explore the glacier-formed landscape and learn more about the Schneeferner on plateau Zugspitze.

FAREWELL VISIT ON ZUGSPITZE

GLACIER TRAIL

Together with the Environmental Research Station Schneefernerhaus, the Glacier Trail was completely revised 2024. The six panels inform you about glaciers, golbal warming, the Environmental Research Station Schneefernerhaus and geology at Zugspitze.

- >> Duration: about 45 minutes | We recommend solid footwear.
- >> The stations are only set up during the summer season and can be explored in any order.

GLACIER TOURS

Interested visitors can explore the world of ice on plateau Zugspitze with the glacier guides.

- >> Twice a day during the summer season (only in good weather)
- >> Duration: about 45 minutes | Solid footwear is required
- >> Free of charge for cable car guests

GARMISCH-CLASSIC ROUND TRIP

EXPERIENCE THE MAGIC OF THE MOUNTAINS

The Garmisch-Classic Round Trip connects all the major attractions of the hiking area: The three cable cars Alpspitzbahn, Hochalmbahn and Kreuzeckbahn take young and old alike into the mountain world of the Wetterstein massif, where they can enjoy fresh mountain air and a fantastic panorama.

UP TO OSTERFELDERKOPF

The Alpspitzbahn cable car takes you up to the Osterfelderkopf. Once there, you can explore the spectacular viewing platform AlpspiX.



DOWN TO HOCHALM

Whether by cable car or by foot, an exciting nature experience awaits you here.



BACK DOWN INTO THE VALLEY

With an impressive panoramic view, the Kreuzeckbahn cable car takes you down to the valley.

















ZUGSPITZE ROUND TRIP

TO THE HIGHLIGHTS OF ZUGSPITZE

Start of the round trip is the Zugspitzbahn station Garmisch, but the trip can also be started at other stops of the cogwheel train. Also possible: go on the round trip in the opposite direction or just use the cogwheel train or the Cable car Zugspitze, to reach the highest mountain in Germany.

RIDE WITH THE COGWHEEL TRAIN

From Garmisch-Partenkirchen it takes 70 minutes via Grainau, past lake Eibsee and through the tunnel to plateau Zugspitze.

UP TO THE SUMMIT

The Gletscherbahn cable car takes you in a few minutes from plateau Zugspitze at 2,600 m a.s.l. to the summit station.

DOWN TO LAKE EIBSEE

The Cable Car Zugspitze takes you back to the valley. From the valley station at lake Eibsee, the cogwheel train brings you back to the starting point.



NATURSTEIG OSTERFELDER

NEW IN SUMMER 2024 IN THE GARMISCH-CLASSIC AREA

At over 30 interactive stations between the Alpspitzbahn mountain station on the Osterfelderkopf and the Kreuzeckbahn mountain station, knowledge about nature and the local mountains is combined with movement elements from Felix Neureuther's "Beweg dich schlau!" initiative. Depending on how much you like hiking, you can also walk only parts of the trail and decide for yourself whether you prefer to hike uphill or downhill.

Section 1: Around Osterfelderkopf

8 stations and the viewing platform AlpspiX | about 500 meters | 30 min.

Section 2: Mountain station Alpspitzbahn cable car - Hochalm Can be skipped with the Hochalmbahn cable car | 16 stations about 2,5 km | 350 altitude meters | downhill 75 min. | uphill 90 min.

Section 3: Hochalm - Mountain station Kreuzeckbahn cable car 7 stations | about 1,5 km | 100 altitude meters | downhill 55 min. | uphill 60 min.

KANDAHAR HIKE MASTER THE CHALLENGE

The legendary Kandahar downhill run is considered one of the most challenging downhill runs in the Alpine Ski World Cup. Who can take on the challenge and conquer the Kandahar uphill in summer? The challenging hiking trail leads from the valley stations of the Kreuzeck- and Alpspitzbahn cable car up to the start of the downhill piste at Kreuzjoch and on to the mountain station of Kreuzeckbahn cable car. A second variant takes hikers from the Tröglhang directly to the Kreuzeckbahn cable car. Information boards along the way also provide interesting background facts about the legendary slope.

Both variants of the Kandahar Hike are challenging trails and are only recommended for experienced hikers with a good level of fitness and surefootedness.

PANORAMIC MOUNT WANK

RELAXED MOUNTAIN EXPERIENCE FOR THE WHOLE FAMILY

Mount Wank might seem unassuming at first compared to its striking neighbours Zugspitze and Alpspitze. Yet it is precisely because there are no craggy cliff faces rising into the sky here, but rather a long summit plateau that invites to linger and stroll along the small circular hiking trail. The panorama mountain is the first choice for leisurely hours on the mountain.

Families, fit seniors, nature lovers and people seeking peace and quiet on Mount Wank they all find a place to refuel, take a breath and relax. Next to the mountain station of the Wankbahn cable car, a naturally designed children's playground offers fun and variety for young visitors. Child-friendly elements invite to scramble, balance and swing in front of the impressive panoramic view of the surrounding mountains.

SONNENALM ON MOUNT WANK

REST WITH PANORAMIC VIEWS

The Sonnenalm restaurant spoils visitors of Mount Wank with bavarian cooking and regional specialities. The fokus is on high-quality, regional and sustainable products. The cozy and brightly designed lounge can hold up to 180 people. Besides incredible panoramic views of the surrounding mountains, the spacious sun terrace offers plenty of sunny seating.
