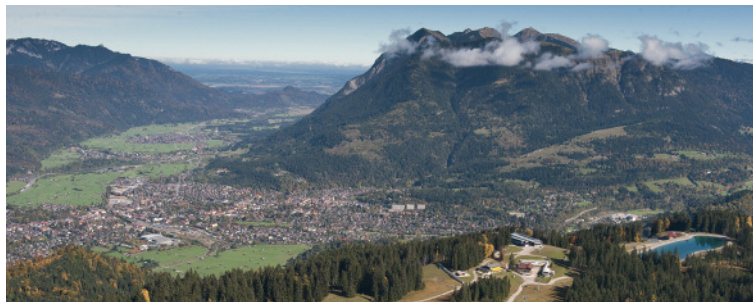

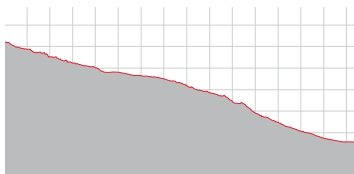


Start: Kreuzeckbahn top terminal

Finish: Garmisch-Partenkirchen

From the top terminal of the Kreuzeckbahn lifts, this tour heads eastwards next to the Hexenkessel lifts. A short time later and after a long forest section, hikers reach the un-serviced Trögl Hut. Now follow the trail that is known in winter as the „Kreuzwankl-Umfahrung – Kreuzwankl-Bypass“ until the top terminal of the Hausbergbahn lifts. Above the reservoir, the route continues through a small forest to Bayernhaus. Take the forest trail from there in the direction of Garmisch-Partenkirchen. After a further 1¼ hour hike through a densely forested area with little clearings, you will arrive at

Kochelbergalm. Continue downhill along the road until you reach the base terminal of the Hausbergbahn lifts (closed in summer). From here, the rack and pinion railway takes you back to the Kreuzeckbahn car park. Alternatively, it is a 15 minute walk to the Zugspitze and Garmisch-Partenkirchen stations.
